

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (U.5531 ROAD, LITTLE LANGDALE)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1980

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

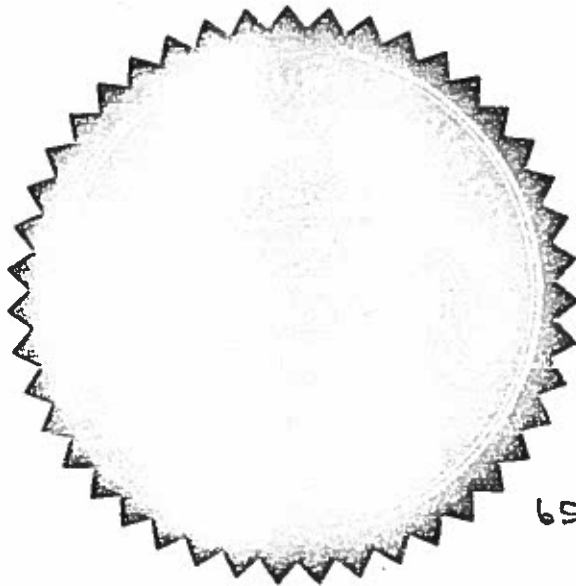
1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of the U.5531 Road in Little Langdale which extends from its junction with the U.5527 Road in Little Langdale to the Ford at its crossing of the River Brathay, except for the purpose of access to premises adjacent to the road.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article, if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or burden to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
 - (b) for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to that length of road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1978;
 - (d) for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (e) if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

3. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st May 1980 and may be cited as the County of Cumbria (U.5531 Road, Little Langdale) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1980.
