THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (U5051 AND U5052 IN THE PARISHES OF COLTON AND SATTERTHWAITE) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES, EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) ORDER 2003

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 3rd March 2003 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (U5051 and U5052 in the Parishes of Colton and Satterthwaite) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Except for Access) Order 2003
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road detailed in the attached Schedule.
3. The restrictions detailed as Items 1 and 2 of the Schedule shall apply only at such times and to such extent as is indicated to drivers and riders by the appropriate traffic signs.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the said Article if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or burden to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road;
 - (b) being used to enable merchandise to be loaded and unloaded;
 - (c) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act, 1984;
 - (d) being used for Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance or Mountain Rescue purposes;
 - (e) being used if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (f) being used in the service of or the employment of the Post Office;
 - (g) being used in connection with the transport of timber, or other forestry operations.

5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purpose of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Except for Access

1. **U5051 in the Parish of Colton**

From its junction with the C5018 at High Nibthwaite northwards and eastwards to its junction with the U5052 (NGR SD 313/925), an approximate distance of 3.7km (2.3 miles);

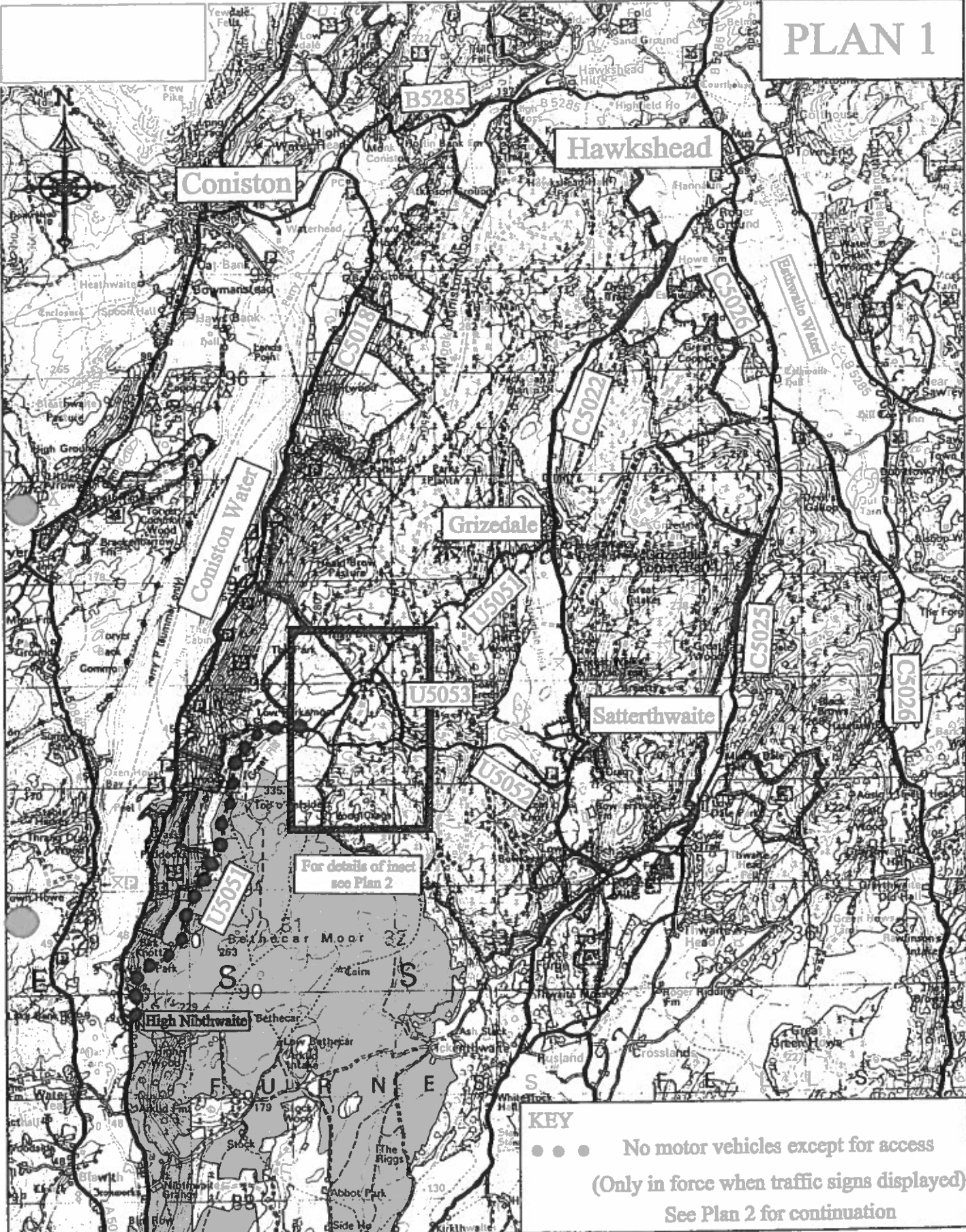
2. **U5052 in the Parishes of Colton and Satterthwaite**

From its junction with the U5051 (NGR SD 313/925) eastwards for a distance of approximately 1260m (0.78 miles) to its junction with BW 566033 (NGR SD 324/923).

3. **U5051 in the Parishes of Colton and Satterthwaite**

From its junction with the U5052 (NGR SD 313/925) in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 750m to a point east of Rowan Tree Dub (NGR SD 318/930) where it meets the forest track, a newly dedicated highway.

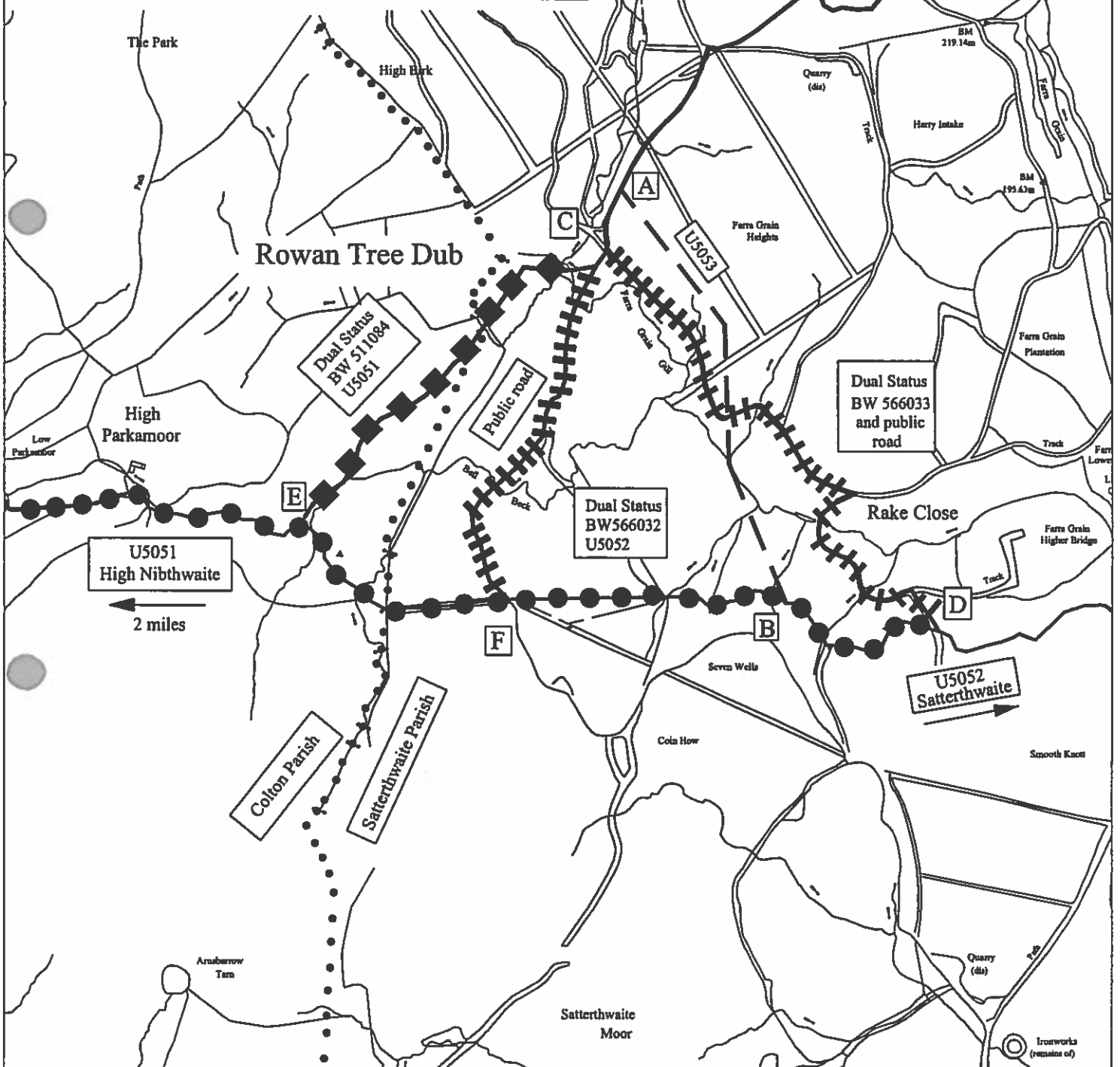
