Do not launch or land in reed beds and wetlands.

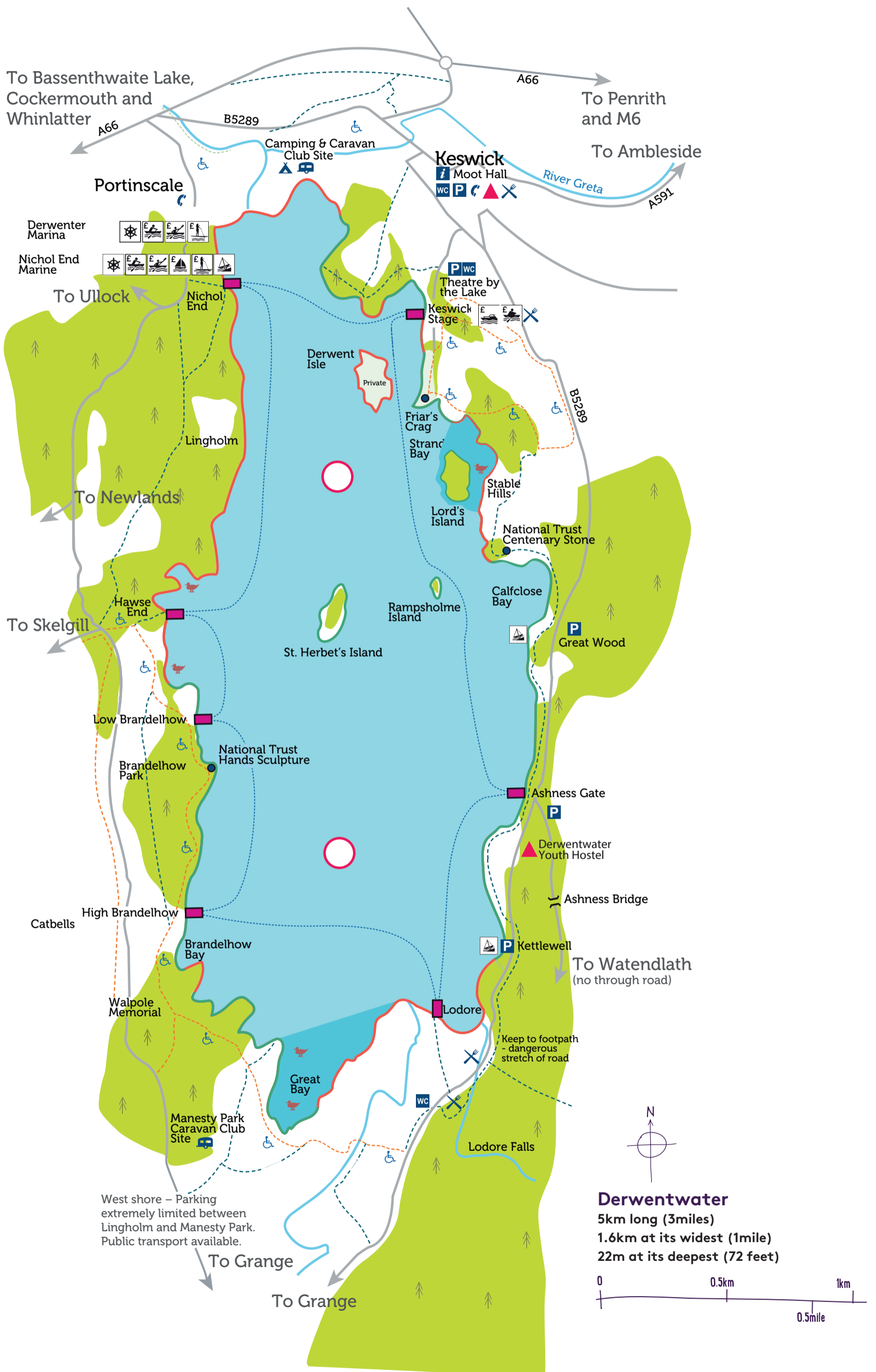
Our rangers and National Trust wardens operate regular patrols of the lake and the shoreline.
