TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2026

WHEREAS the Lake District National Park Authority (hereinafter referred to as “the Authority”) being the Agent for Westmorland and Furness Council for Footpath 542021, and the unrecorded way generally uses as part of Footpath 542021 at Grasmere, Lakes (Grasmere) Parish, is satisfied that all public traffic on the said highway should be prohibited to enable re-surfacing works.

NOW THEREFORE the Authority in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf **HEREBY MAKE** the following order:

- 1 No public traffic shall proceed along that section of Footpath 542021, and the unrecorded way generally used as part of Footpath 542021, between NY 3383 0808 and NY 3403 0811, in Lakes (Grasmere) Parish.
- 2 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3 This order shall come into operation on 23 February 2026 and will continue in force for six months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
- 4 This order may be cited as the Lake District National Park Authority (Footpath 542021 and unrecorded way generally used as part of Footpath 542021, Tenters Path, Grasmere, Lakes (Grasmere) Parish) Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2026.

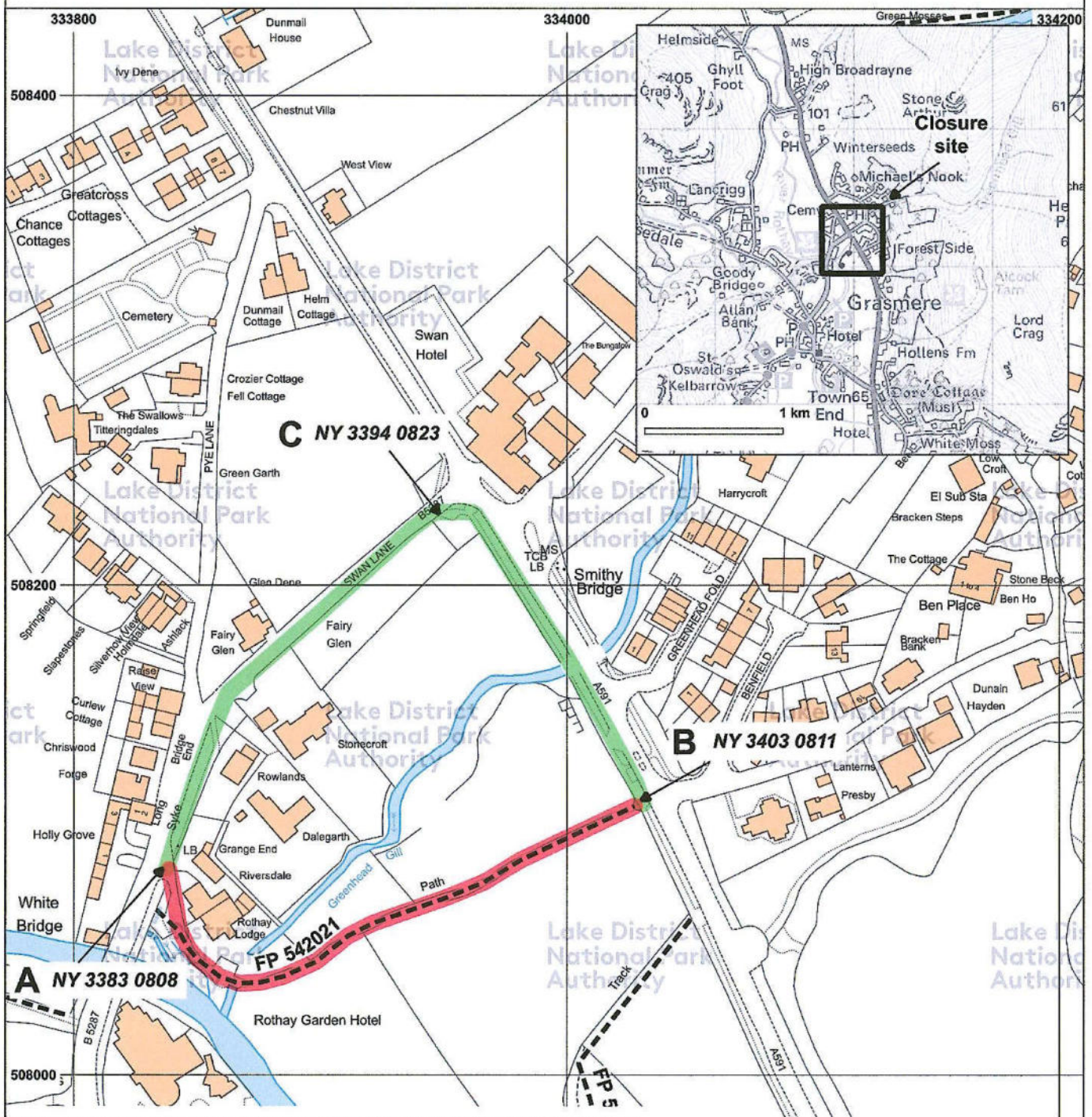

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS GIVEN that under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Lake District National Park Authority has made an Order dated 17 February 2026. The effect of the order is to prohibit public traffic for all purposes from proceeding over Footpath 542021 (known as the Tenters Path), and the unrecorded way generally used as part of Footpath 542021, Lakes (Grasmere) Parish, between NY 3383 0808 and NY 3403 0811, to enable re-surfacing works.

The notice and plan showing the route concerned may be inspected during normal office or opening hours at the National Park Authority, Wayfaring House, Murley Moss, Oxenholme Road, Kendal, LA9 7RL; at Westmorland & Furness Council Customer Services, South Lakeland House, Lowther Street, Kendal, LA9 4DQ; and online at www.lakedistrict.gov.uk/rowclosures.

The order will take effect on 23 February 2026 and will continue in force for six months, or until the works are complete, if earlier. It is anticipated the works will take only around two weeks. If the works have not been completed the Order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the Secretary of State.
