**PROPOSED BOOTLE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN: DESIGNATION OF  
NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA**

An application has been made by Bootle Parish Council for designation of a Neighbourhood Area under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The application was publicised on the Authorities website for six weeks from 8 April to 20 May 2014. No comments were received objecting to the designation.

We consider the parish to be the area most appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area for planning purposes. We also consider Bootle Parish Council to be a 'relevant body' for the purposes of the 1990 Act, and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning.

We agree to designate Bootle Parish as a neighbourhood area for the purposes of drafting a neighbourhood plan.
