**NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012**

**PROPOSED CROSTHWAITE AND LYTH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN:  
DESIGNATION OF NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA**

An application has been made by Crosthwaite and Lyth Parish Council for designation of a Neighbourhood Area under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The application was publicised on the Authority's website for five weeks from 30 July to 03 September 2018. No comments were received objecting to the designation, and one comment was received supporting the designation.

We consider Crosthwaite and Lyth Parish to be the area most appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area for planning purposes. We also consider Crosthwaite and Lyth Parish Council to be a 'relevant body' for the purposes of the 1990 Act, and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning.

We agree to designate Crosthwaite and Lyth Civil Parish as a neighbourhood area for the purposes of drafting a neighbourhood plan.
