**PROPOSED KESWICK NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN: DESIGNATION OF
NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA**

An application has been made by Keswick Town Council for designation of a Neighbourhood Area under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The application was publicised on the Authority's website for six weeks from 17 July to 28 August 2017. No comments were received objecting to the designation, and one comment was received supporting the designation.

We consider Keswick Civil Parish plus an area of Underskiddaw Civil Parish to the south of A66 to be the area most appropriate to be designated as a neighbourhood area for planning purposes. We also consider Keswick Town Council to be a 'relevant body' for the purposes of the 1990 Act, and is therefore qualified to undertake neighbourhood planning.

We agree to designate Keswick Civil Parish plus an area of Underskiddaw Civil Parish to the south of the A66 as a neighbourhood area for the purposes of drafting a neighbourhood plan.
