The Lake District National Park Authority has determined that the draft Matterdale Neighbourhood Development Plan is not likely to have significant environmental effects and does not therefore require a full Strategic Environmental Assessment.

In accordance with Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulation 9, this determination has been made in liaison with Natural England, English Heritage and the Environment Agency.
