TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS GIVEN that under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Lake District National Park Authority has made an order dated 6 May 2026. The effect of the order is to prohibit public traffic for all purposes from proceeding over Bridleway 201006 between NY 2092 2452 and NY 2209 2515 at Thornthwaite Forest, and Footpath 201044 between NY 2147 2639 and NY 2119 2649 at Beckstones Gill, Above Derwent Parish, to enable forestry thinning works.

The notice and plans showing the route concerned may be inspected during normal office or opening hours at the National Park Authority, Wayfaring House, Murley Moss, Oxenholme Road, Kendal, LA9 7RL; at Cumberland Council Customer Services, Allerdale House, New Bridge Road, Workington, CA14 3YJ; and at Keswick Post Office, 4 Bank Street, Keswick, CA12 5JY; and online at www.lakedistrict.gov.uk/rowclosures.

The order will take effect on 11 May 2026 and will continue in force for six months. When works are taking place, signs will be erected indicating the closed sections of the paths and the alternative routes. When the paths are not being affected by the works they will be accessible as normal. If the works have not been completed the order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the Secretary of State.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2026

WHEREAS the Lake District National Park Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") being the Agent for Cumberland Council for Bridleway 201006 at Thornthwaite Forest and Footpath 201044 at Beckstones Gill, Above Derwent Parish, is satisfied that all public traffic on the said highways should be prohibited to enable forestry thinning works.

NOW THEREFORE the Authority in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf HEREBY MAKE the following order:

- 1 No public traffic shall proceed along those sections of Bridleway number 201006 between NY 2092 2452 and NY 2209 2515, and Footpath 201044 between NY 2147 2639 and NY 2119 2649, in Above Derwent Parish.
- 2 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3 This order shall come into operation on 11 May 2026 and will continue in force for six months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
- 4 This order may be cited as the Lake District National Park Authority (Bridleway 201006 and Footpath 201044, Thornthwaite Forest and Beckstones Gill, Above Derwent Parish) Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2026.

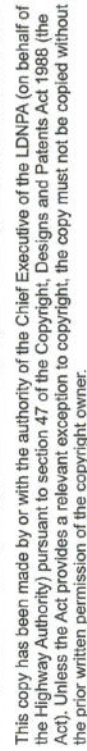

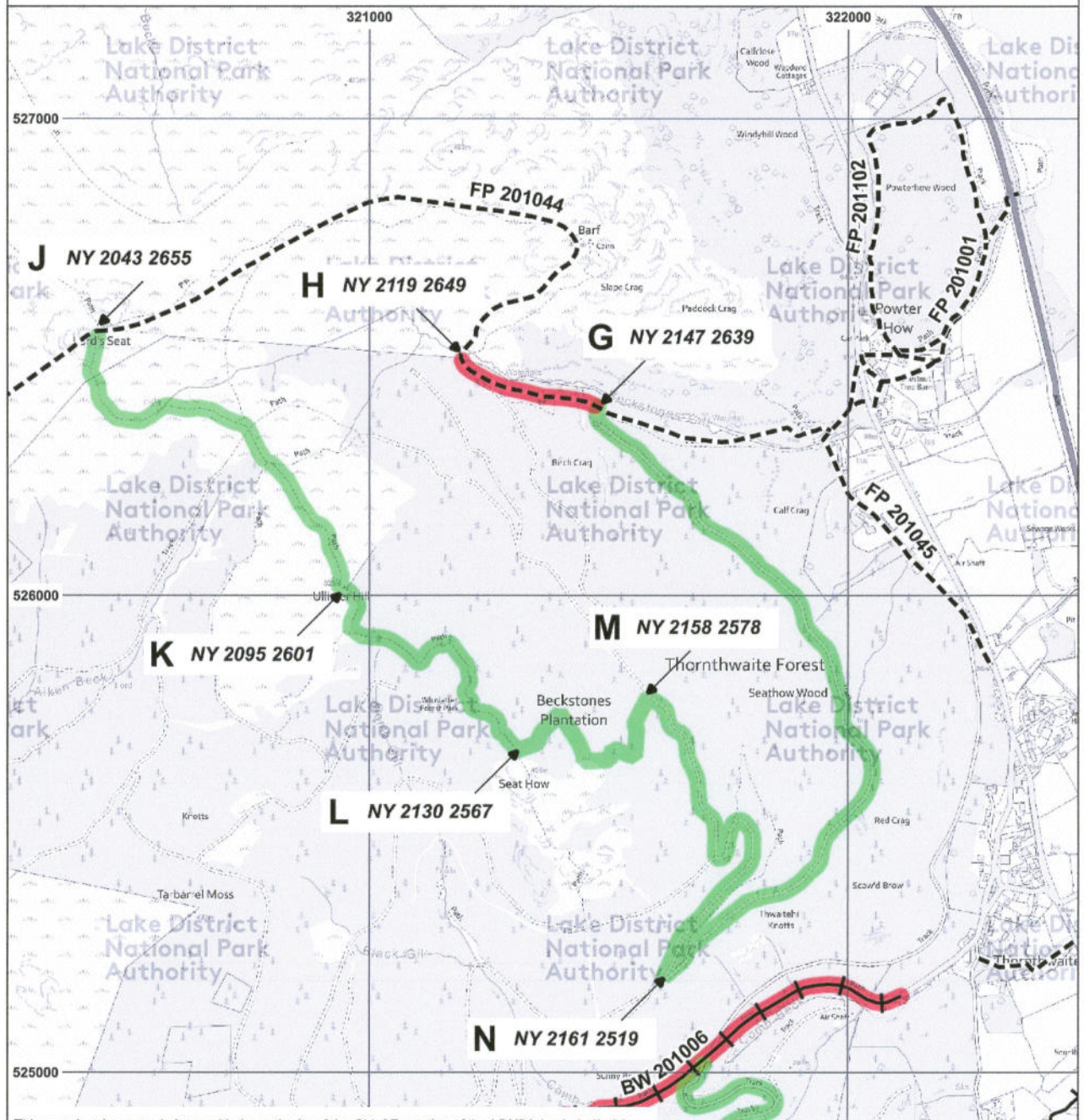
