

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1977

LAKE DISTRICT SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD

WHEREAS

(1) The Lake District Special Planning Board (hereinafter called "the Board") is the local planning authority for the area of the Lake District National Park

(2) The Board is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the Class specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be carried out in the area hereinafter mentioned unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

(3) The Board is acting under powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order")

NOW THEREFORE the Board direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto in the area of land edged in red on the plan annexed hereto comprising Ordnance Survey Field Numbers 6000, 6200, 6420, 6539, 6700, 6969, 7056, 7210, 7318, 7330, 7800, 7961, 7988, 8117 and 8718 at Thirlspot Farm, Thirlmere, Keswick in the County of Cumbria in the Lake District National Park

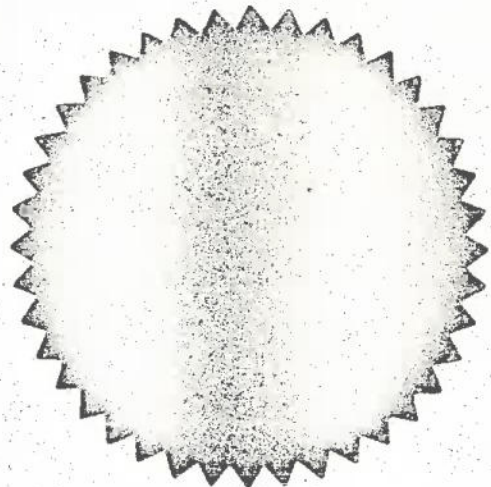

SCHEDULECLASS OF DEVELOPMENT

Development within Class IV (2) of the First Schedule to the Order insofar as the same permits the use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for the purpose of camping on not more than twenty eight days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use

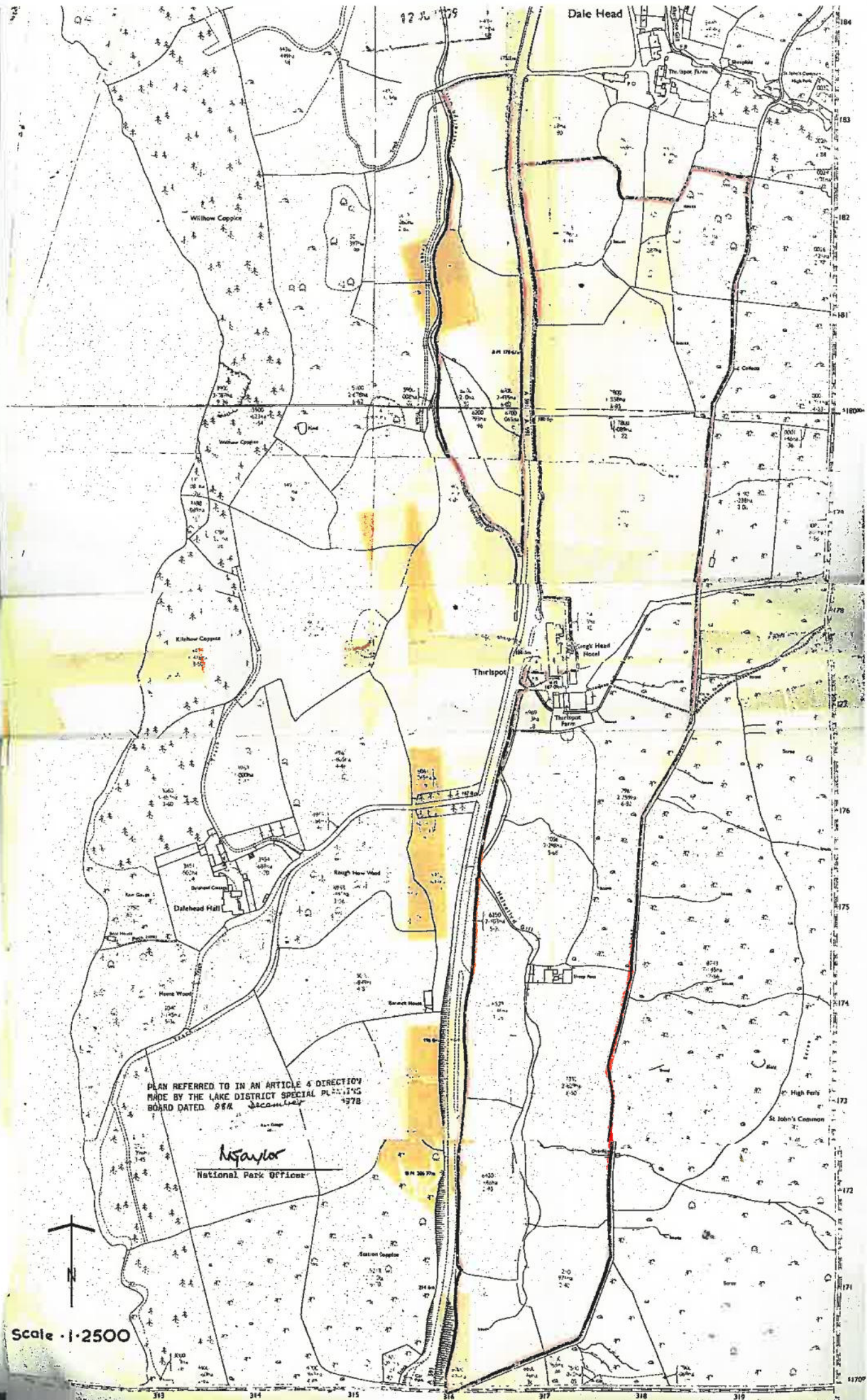
