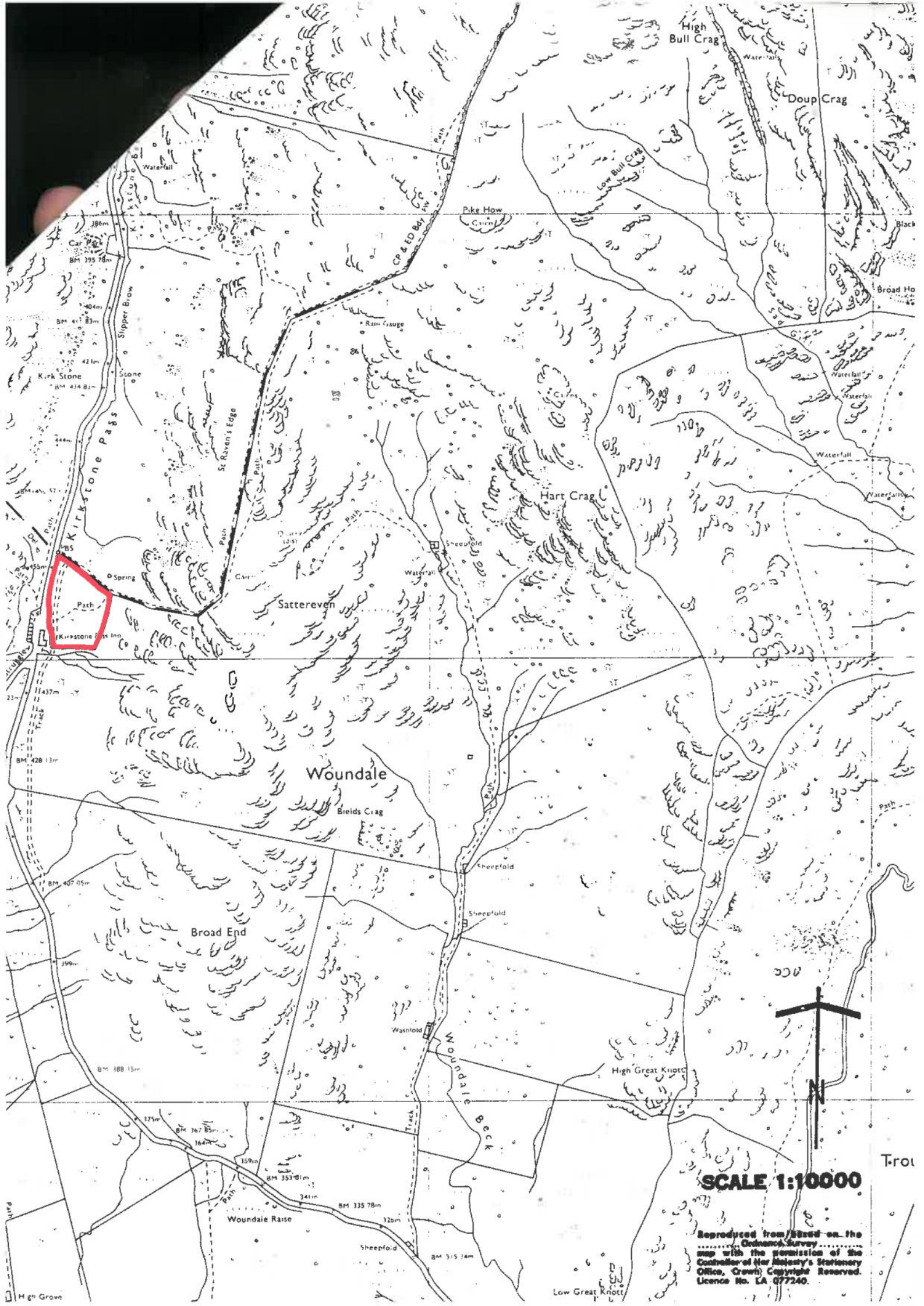


TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1977
LAKE DISTRICT SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD

WHEREAS

1. The Lake District Special Planning Board (hereinafter called "the Board") is the local planning authority for the area of the Lake District National Park
2. The Board is satisfied that it is expedient that the development of the Class specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be carried out in the area mentioned unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf
3. It is the opinion of the Board that development of the Class specified in the Schedule hereto if carried out without planning permission granted in that behalf would be contrary to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area
4. The Board is acting under the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 (1) and 4 (3) (b) of the Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order 1977 (hereinafter called "the Order")
5. In pursuance of the provisions of Article 4 (3) (b) of the Order this Direction shall take effect immediately

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD DIRECT that with effect from the date of this Order the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto on the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto and situate in the District of South Lakeland in the Lake District National Park at Kirkstone Pass Ambleside in the County of Cumbria

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THIS Direction shall remain in force for a period of six months from the date on which it is served and shall then expire unless it has before the termination of the said six months been approved by the Secretary of State or it is disallowed by the Secretary of State at any time during the period of six months whereupon it shall cease to have effect

SCHEDULE

Class of Development

Development within Class IV (2) of the First Schedule to the Order, that is, the use of land for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site for not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purpose of that use not being development comprised within any other class.
