

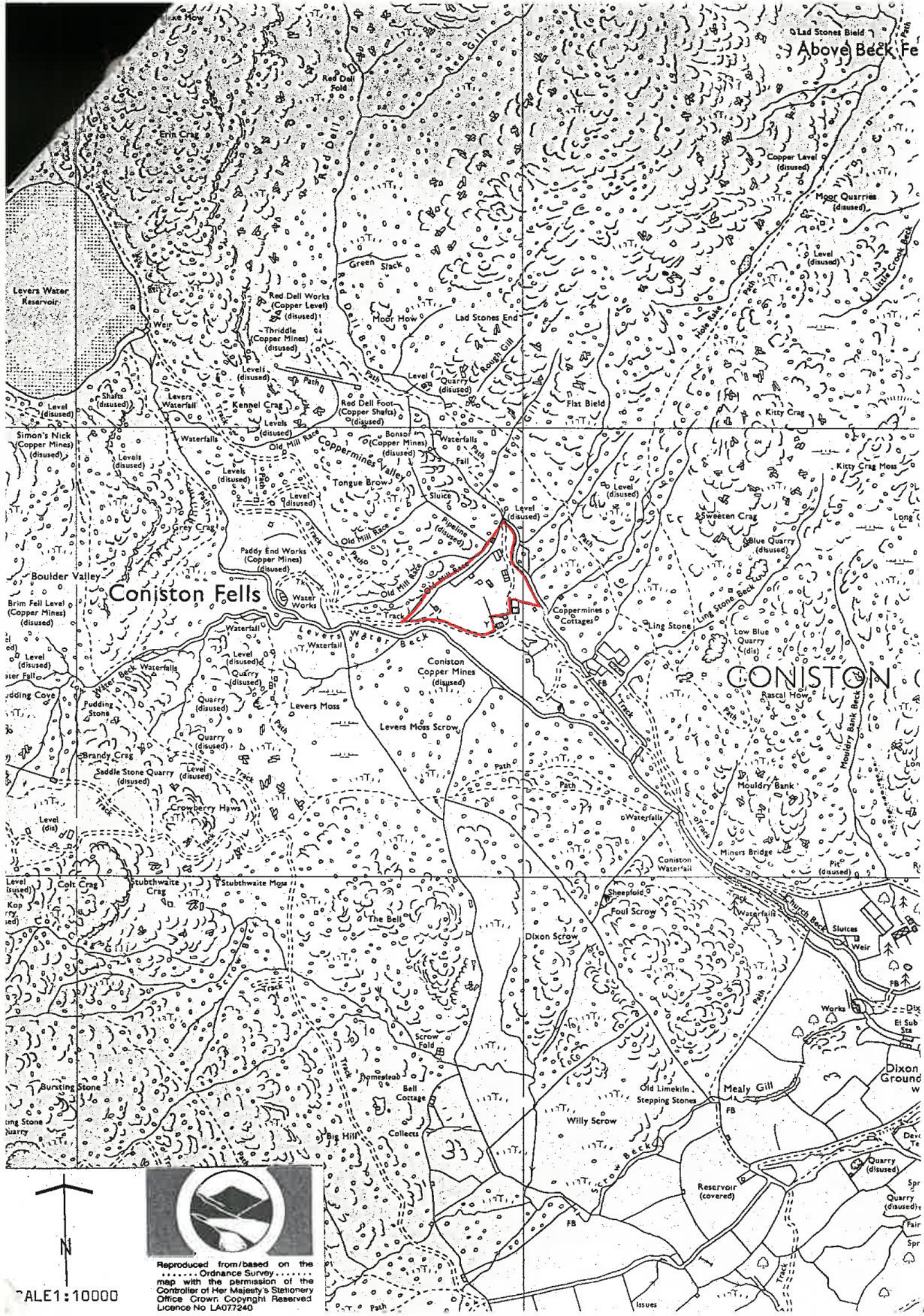
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977-1987
LAKE DISTRICT SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD

WHEREAS:-

1. The Lake District Special Planning Board (hereinafter called "the Board") is the local planning authority for the area of the Lake District National Park
2. The Board is satisfied that it is expedient that the development of the Class specified in the Schedule hereto shall not be carried out in the area mentioned unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf
3. The Board is acting under the powers conferred on it by Article 4(1) and 4(3)(b) of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977-87 (hereinafter called "the Order")
5. In pursuance of the provisions of Article 4(3)(b) of the Order this Direction shall take effect immediately

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD DIRECT that with effect from the date of approval of this Order the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto on the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto and situated in the District of South Lakeland in the Lake District National Park at the Old Coppermines Coppermines Valley Coniston in the County of Cumbria

THIS Direction shall remain in force for a period of six months from the date on which it is served and shall then expire unless it has before the termination of the six months been approved by the Secretary of State or it is disallowed by the Secretary of State at any time during the period of six months whereupon it shall cease to have effect

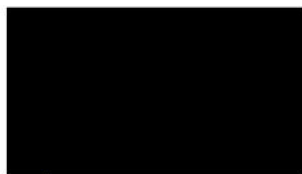
SCHEDULE

Class of Development

Development within Class II paragraph 1 of the First Schedule to the Order, that is,
the erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not
exceeding 1 metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or
2 metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other
alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure so long as such
improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate
for a new means of enclosure
