

ARTICLE FOUR DIRECTION

LAKE DISTRICT NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1995

Direction under Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2010 (SI 2010/654)

RECITALS

1. THE LAKE DISTRICT NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY ("the Authority") is the local planning authority in respect of the area of the land specified in this Direction.
2. The Authority is satisfied that it is no longer expedient that development described in Schedule 2 to the General Permitted Development Order 1995 ("the Order") and prohibited in a Direction dated Eighteenth day of December One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Seven should not be carried out unless permission is granted for it on application.

NOW THEREFORE the Authority in pursuance of Article 4 of the Order and all other powers thereby enabling

DIRECT THAT

1. The Article 4 Direction made by the Authority on 18 December 1957 is cancelled in the area specified in the Schedule to this Direction ("the Land").
2. It is expressly provided that this Direction shall apply to the area of land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto and situate in the parish of Windermere in the Lake District National Park known as land at Storrs adjoining Cannon Hey Windermere and formerly known as land near "the Pines" Storrs Park Windermere.

3. Pursuant to Article 5(1) of the Order, this Direction does not require the approval of the Secretary of State because it relates only to the cancellation of a previous direction. The Direction shall expire at the end of six months from the date upon which it is made unless the Authority confirms the Direction beforehand. The Direction shall, in accordance with Article 5(10) of the Order, come into force in respect of any part of the Land on that date on which notice of the making of the Direction is served on the occupier of that part of the Land or, if there is no occupier, the owner. If the Authority consider that individual service on the owners or occupiers of the Land is impracticable because the number of them makes such service impracticable or because it is difficult to identify or locate one or more of them, the Authority shall publish a notice of making of the Direction in a newspaper circulating in the locality in which the Land is situated and, in accordance with Article 5(15) of the Order, the Direction shall come into effect on the date on which the notice is first published.
